

Instructions for using Room View Feature When Uploading New Inventory

There are a few dimensions that are on the screen, and they will be used in this order:


1. The separate dimension fields - width & height
2. The framed dimension (the program looks for the X to separate the width & height)
3. The unframed dimension (the program looks for the X to separate the width & height)
